
## <u>Chancel Primary Uniform Questionnaire Analysis – January 2022</u>

A total of 86 parents completed this questionnaire, and returned to school for analysis – this would equate to approximately 40 to 50% (based on the number of siblings in school).

1. Are you aware of Chancel Primary School's current school uniform requirements?




100% of respondents indicated they were aware of uniform requirements.

2. Do you find it easy to locate and purchase items of Chancel Uniform?




More than 88% of respondents found it easy to locate and purchase Chancel Uniform.

3. How would you describe the quality of Chancel Uniform?



The vast majority of parents stated that the quality of Chancel Uniform is good with 20% describing it as excellent and 12% indicating uniform quality was poor (reasons for this are discussed in the comments section).

4. How would you describe the Value for Money of Chancel Uniform?




As expected the comments regarding Value for Money [VfM] very much mirrored those for quality of uniform — with some slight disparities. Again, the vast majority described Chancel uniform as 'good', with only 12% selecting 'excellent' and 20% stating VfM of Chancel uniform was poor.

5. Would you prefer Chancel Uniform was available at more than one supplier?




Almost 80% of completed questionnaires received, indicated parents would prefer uniform was available from more than one supplier. Surprisingly this was not the case for more than 20% of respondents, who are happy with the current system. The current service/quality of goods from BluePrint was stated as a reason for some.

6. Do you feel able to purchase Chancel Uniform items from local supermarkets?




There were a range of responses received, detailing items available/ unavailable from supermarkets. Most parents seemed able to purchase standard uniform items (trousers, skirts, dresses...) from supermarkets – although larger sizes appear to be more difficult to acquire. Some respondents indicated they would like to be able to purchase more <u>Chancel</u> uniform items from supermarkets.

## 7. How would you describe the number of uniform items requiring Chancel logo?




Almost 80% of respondents indicated the number of uniform items requiring school logo as being 'just right'. However, there are almost 20 parents who felt it was too many.

## 8. As an eco-friendly school would you like the opportunity to access pre-loved uniform?



An interesting response to this question, with a significant number indicating they would like access to pre-loved uniform – particularly as this is not reflected in the number of people requesting/accessing 'used' uniform, when on offer in school.

## 9. How would you prefer pre-loved uniform be offered?



The most popular choice for accessing pre-loved uniform was 'Community Pre-loved Site', with termly/half-termly in school a close second.

Parents were also provided with an option for additional comments, below are the most common responses received:



None of the above comments received more than fourteen responses (poor quality of uniform was commented upon by thirteen parents – some as part of the 'quality' and 'VfM' questions above), the main concern raised by parents was the fact that the polo shirts fade too quickly.

Some parents commented negatively (others positively) on the newly introduced PE Hoody – this decision was made in light of several classes being scheduled to participate in PE on the same day; because children now come into school wearing their PE Kit, staff felt pupils were dressing for a 'non-uniform day' – some PE outfits worn were 'interesting' colour and outfit choices to say the least. With the wearing of PE Kit to school proving such a success, (due to no time wasted while children change for PE, and no dirty/smelly kits hanging around school for weeks on end), we will continue to encourage pupils to attend in PE Uniform, looking smart in uniform colours (making the winter hoody a requirement). Chancel's PE Coordinator will be providing letters for parents of pupils who are not wearing the correct PE Uniform, advising that their child must come into school wearing normal school uniform (changing into their PE Kit for their PE Lesson only).

The following are agreed actions/considerations:

- Ensure Chancel uniform is available from more than one supplier;
- Respond to local/national surveys with regard to more uniform being available to purchase via supermarkets;
- Ensure the number of uniform items requiring the school logo remain at the minimum, with the requirement made clear in the uniform policy;
- Ensure pre-loved Chancel uniform is available for parents to purchase in light of previous attempts in school, we would look to participate in a community pre-loved uniform event;
- Share questionnaire feedback with BluePrint, who can then monitor quality of polo shirts;
- Continue to encourage pupils to wear PE Kit to school (including new hoody, promoting smart appearance and uniform colours);
- PE Coordinator to provide letter for staff to issue to parents of pupils not wearing correct PE Uniform.
