They are also given fruit, salad sticks and a cake or biscuit.

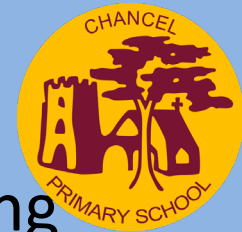
If you do not wish for your child to be able to order a sandwich bag at lunch time please let school know.

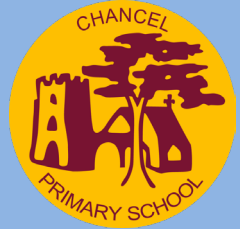

Spellings tests are every Friday morning, the spellings can be found on our school website.

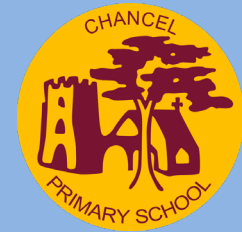

Spellings will be tested on Friday mornings.

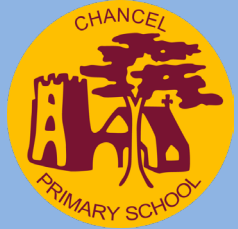

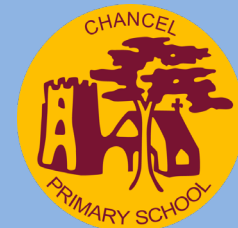
School bags

When children move up into Year 6, they get the choice of bringing their own school bag in.





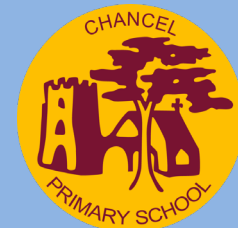
Lost Property

To ensure the correct property gets back to the correct child, every item must have their name in please.

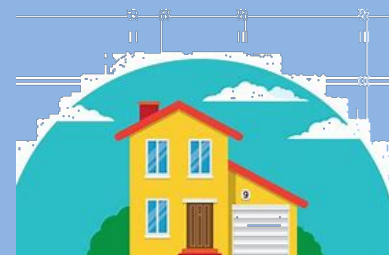


Home Time
