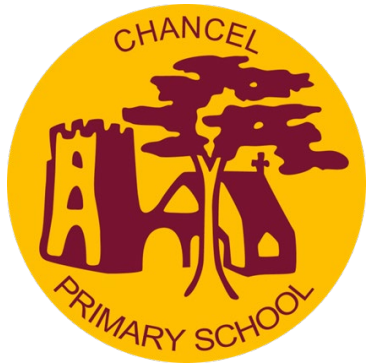

To work as a team by discussing and sharing ideas in small groups to support their learning.

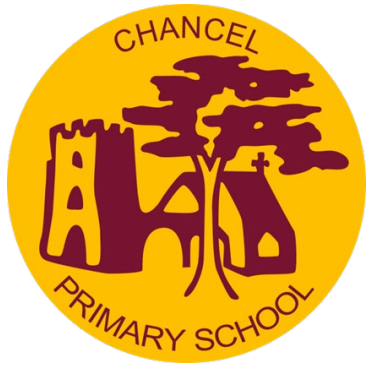

Children's progress

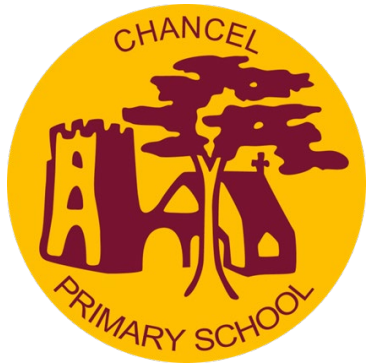
Progress reports are sent home in October/November and March.

P.E Days



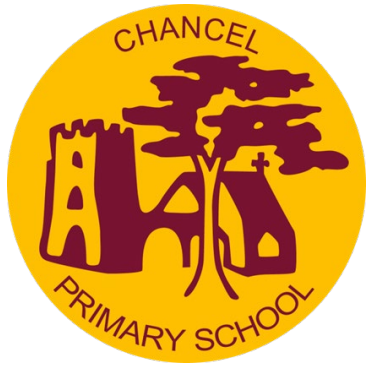
Autumn 1 - Thursday - Invasion Games

Earrings must not be worn for PE - If recently pierced, please collect a permission letter from the office.



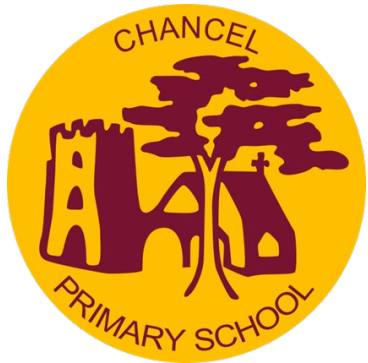
Lunchtimes

Children can choose their filling; ham, cheese or tuna. They are also given fruit, salad sticks and a cake or biscuit.



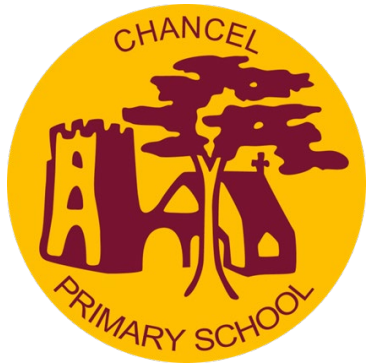
Reading At Home

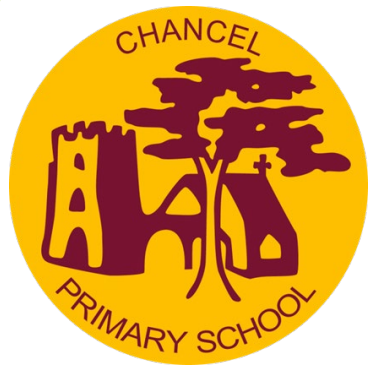

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Children will also be encouraged to spend some time on Doodle Maths and TimesTable Rockstars to continue their learning at home.



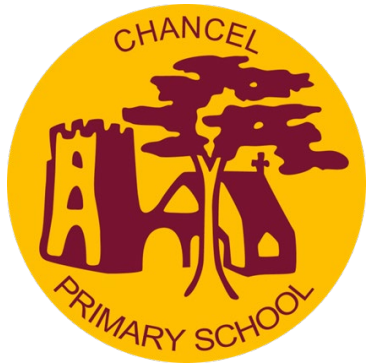
Rewards and Sanctions

We also give our Dojos, stickers, team points and prizes throughout the day!

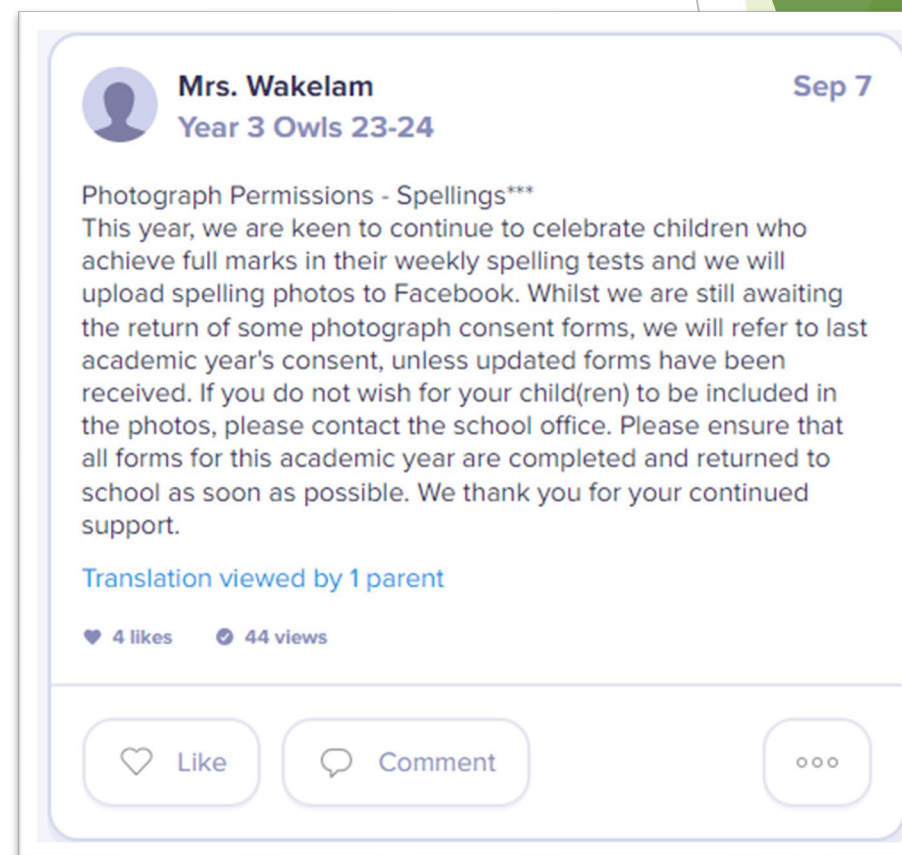


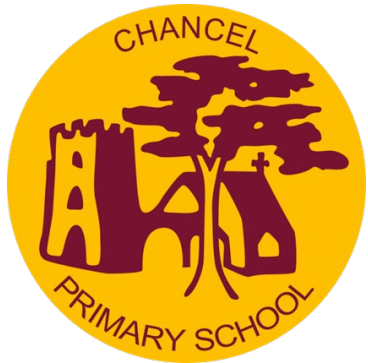


Classroom Communication

Whilst we used Class Dojo as a messaging service during lockdown, it is now predominantly used to send messages to parents via class story.





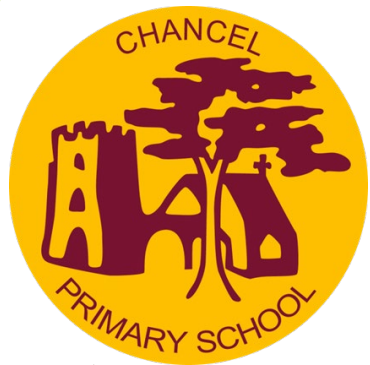
Home Time
