



Autumn 2 - Monday and Thursday - Dance and Invasion Games


Children to arrive at school in their PE kit so that they are ready for when their PE lesson starts.


You can use child's Reading Record to record your child's reading progress at home.

### Rewards and Sanctions

At Chancel, we like to rewards children for their fantastic efforts and attitudes towards their learning and the school environment.

In class, we have a behaviour wheel which enables children to start the day with a super attitude and aim towards ending the day on fantastic! The behaviour wheel also enables children to have sanctions throughout the day, if needed, but offers them a chance to think about their behaviour and aim to get back on track before the day ends.
