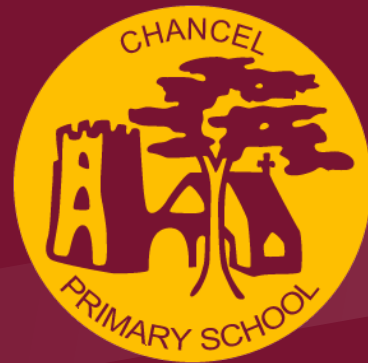

As dismissing time can be quite hectic, please be patient as teachers make their way through the line.

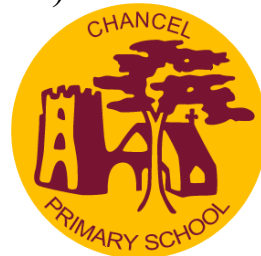

■ Arithmetic – evening practice (test weekly – Monday)

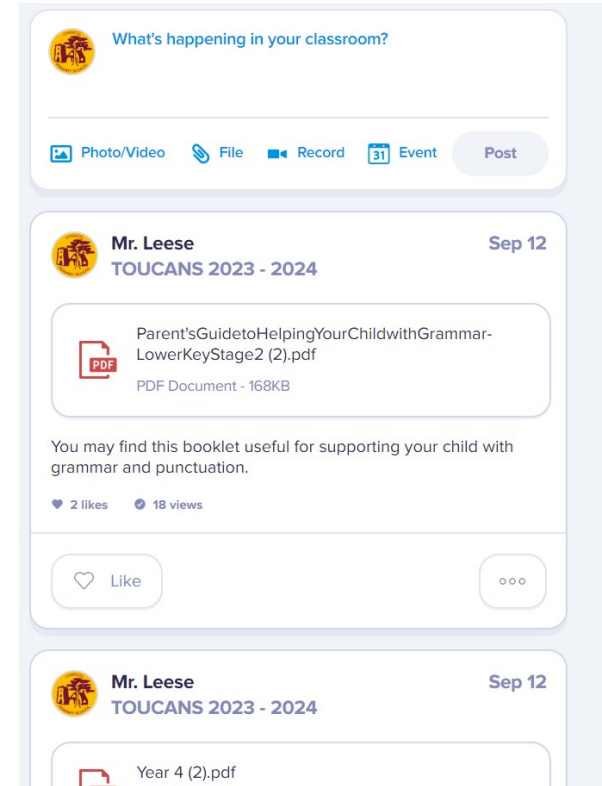
# Class Trips

- We used ClassDojo as a messaging service during lockdowns but it is now mainly used for ClassStory.



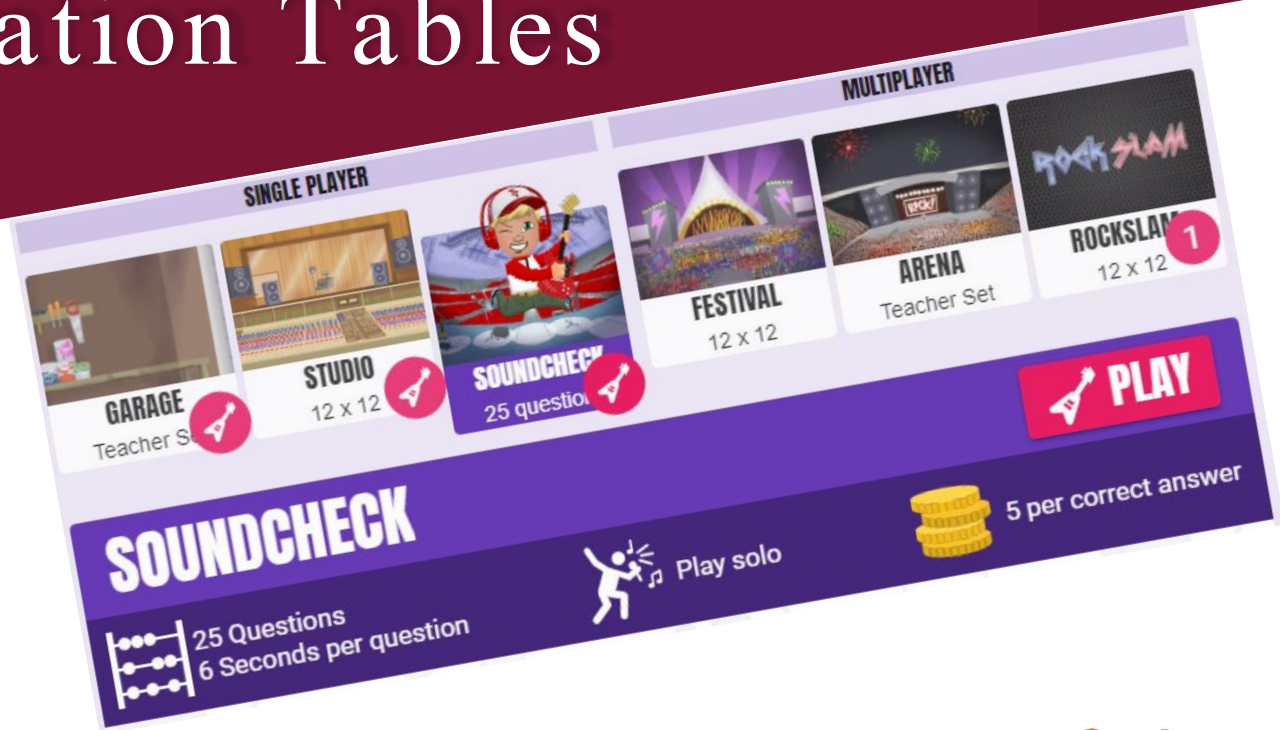

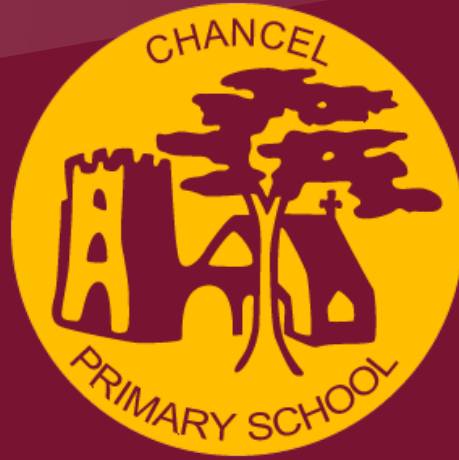
